



## MINERVA ACADEMY PUPIL PREMIUM IMPACT

The Pupil Premium is Government funding, in addition to main funding and was introduced in April 2011. It is allocated to schools to work with pupils who have been registered for free school meals at any point in the last six years (known as 'Ever 6 FSM'). It is also allocated to Looked After Children (LAC)

The value of Pupil Premium in 2016-2017 is £1,320 per pupil.

£65,000 was the total amount allocated in 2015-2016

The Pupil Premium allocation for this year to date is £75,240.

55.9% of pupils at Minerva Academy are entitled to pupil premium.

In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, we recognize that not all pupils who are in receipt of free school meals will be socially disadvantaged. Also not all pupils who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for free school meals. Provision will not be aimed at Statemented children as funding for need is already in place.

The Pupil Premium funded is deployed in the manner described in this Pupil Premium document with the intention of closing the gap in attainment between disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged children.

### **Impact**

Our RAISEonline 2015-2016 Summary Report which is an analysis of our data carried out by Ofsted shows that our pupil premium children are performing well in comparison to national averages.

Year 1 – Phonics Screening Check – 100% of Pupil Premium pupils achieved the expected standard compared to the national average of 66%

Year 2 – Phonics Screening Check – 100% of PP pupils achieved the expected standard compared to the national average of 90%
